ØYVIND HJELMEN has been working with photography for more than 25 years, his works have been exhibited in 14 countries, and have been aquired by public and private collections. Apart from teaching his own workshops, he has been guest lecturing internationally at colleges and universities.

Øyvind Hjelmen has had three books published: Sentimental (2005), Ride the Wind, with Per Jan Ingebrigtsen (2009) and Elsewhere (Kehrer Verlag 2011)

THE WORKSHOP will focus on a personal approach to photography, whether you are searching for your own personal expression, or you are looking to hone the expression you have already achieved.



We encourage participants to be open minded and willing to experiment in their search for expression. This will not be a technical workshop, but if needed technical advice will be given.

There will be lectures giving a multitude of inputs, and daily feedback on the participants work as we progress. There will also be one – to – one sessions, where participants will be able to discuss in depth their photographic and artistic challenges. The workshop will be held in English.

Our base will be at Galerie Depardieu, where all lectures will be held. The gallery is situated very close to the Old Town.
