Øyvind Hjelman has published four books: *Sentimental* (2005), *Ride the Wind*, with Per Jan Ingebrigtsen (2009), *Elsewhere* (Kehrer Verlag 2011), and *Light and Shadow*, with Per Jan Ingebrigtsen (2018).

the 4th, and will end in the evening
Thursday 7th November, following the
vernissage of Øyvind's new exhibition
at the gallery.

The workshop will focus on how we
work on a photographic project, from
planning and shooting, through editing,
to different ways of presentation.
Also, how to proceed after your project
is finished, if you are looking for
exhibition- or publishing possibilities.



Participants will receive a more detailed program after registration.

There will be lectures giving a multitude of inputs, and daily feedback on the participants work as we progress. This will not be a technical workshop, but if needed, technical advice will be given.

The workshop will be held in English.

Our base will be at Galerie Depardieu, where all lectures will be held.
The gallery is situated very close to the Old Town.

The workshop fee is 300 Euros.

When you apply for the workshop, you will be sent a registration form and an invoice for a deposit of 50 Euros. When the deposit has been paid, your space in the workshop is guaranteed. After the application deadline, the deposit will be returned to you only if the workshop should be cancelled.
